### Upcoming Discussions and Events happening at Unami

February 4, 11am - Unami Friends will continue our experiment with semiprogrammed Inter-generational Meeting for Worship on the first Sunday of each month. This will be a different worship experience then our usual meeting for worship. As worship begins, an adult Friend will share a short, prepared introduction (10 minutes or less) of a topic, theme or story that they have prepared and intend to be of interest and meaning to Friends of all ages. Intergenerational means "everything is for everyone!" All Friends are welcome to sit on the floor for the story and worship. There will be materials available (paper, crayons, pipe cleaners, stuffed animals etc.) that are conducive to inward listening. There will be no childcare provided – parents may accompany their child to one of the classrooms if they feel a need for some time away from the group. This experiment is a 'work in progress' and we encourage your feedback as we proceed through the year. We will need help.
