Message from the Treasurer

We have just received notice of a grant of \$5000 from the PYM Building Improvement Granting Group for our windows and painting project. We had requested \$10,000.

We have also received \$5,000 from an AQM grant. Our total budget to complete the project is \$20,000.

The project includes replacing all of the old windows, the front door and re-painting the exterior of the building.

We currently have a Reserve fund balance of \$17,325. The reserve fund was initially established for emergency building needs. We need to decide if we can proceed with the full project at this time. **We could do so by spending down our reserve fund or seek one-time donations from members and attenders.**
