Work List

Inside Cleaning:

Clean inside building.
Clean floors.
Clean toilets.
Clean windows.

Inside Handyperson Work:

Finish installing deadbolts for Utility Room door and for closet door in First Day School Room.
Test batteries of smoke detectors and replace as needed.
Put screens in windows.
Outside door in First Day Room is sticky and needs to be lubricated.

Outdoors Work:

Cut grass
Clean-out rain gutter above the front entrance where it is clogged.
Make sure the downspout extenders are in position on the Macoby side of building.
Remove poison ivy in back corner area of yard where kids have built a fort.
Remove blade from lawnmower and get it sharpened.
Mark trees to be removed with a flag. This includes the Red Bud in front of the banner, and an old Rhododendron in front of building.
Get rid of debris from old, gray lawnmower pop-up shed behind Meetinghouse.
Kids can pick up sticks in yard and put in pile at back corner.
Add a hanger under the sign with a piece of wood that has the time of Meeting for Worship.

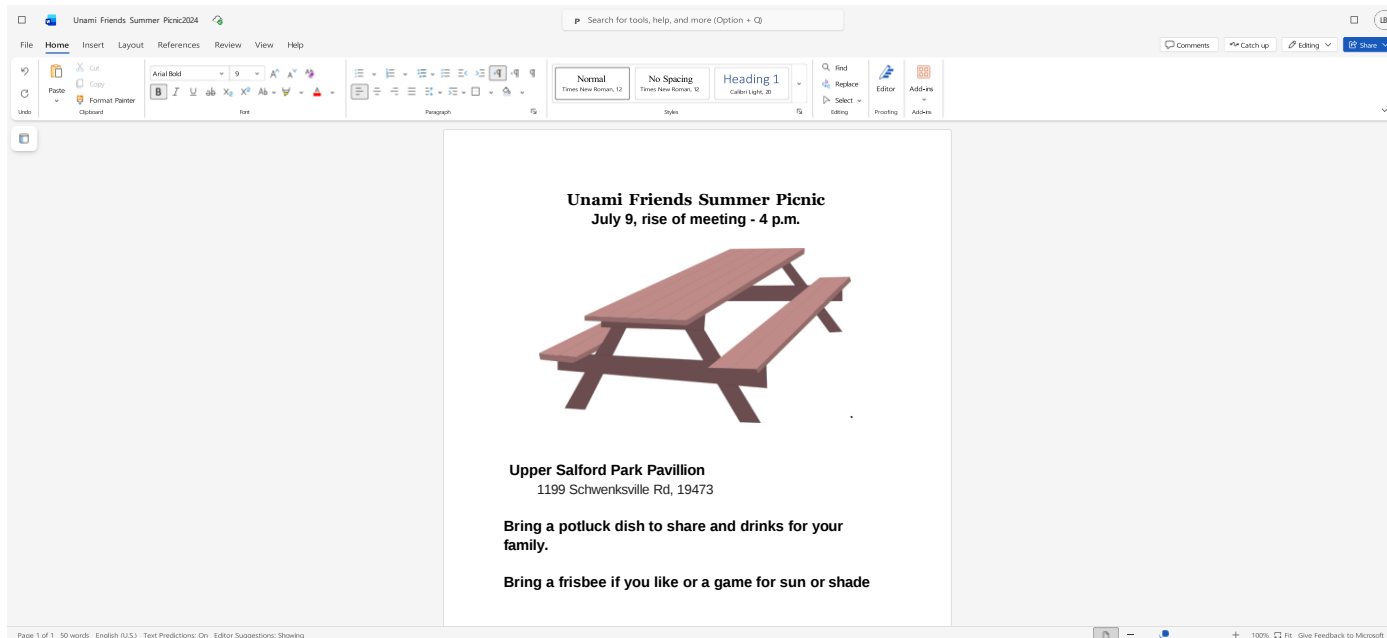
